Training for this project will be on the 30th of January at Lincs from 6 til 7.30 and all volunteers will receive tickets for Festivale on that night

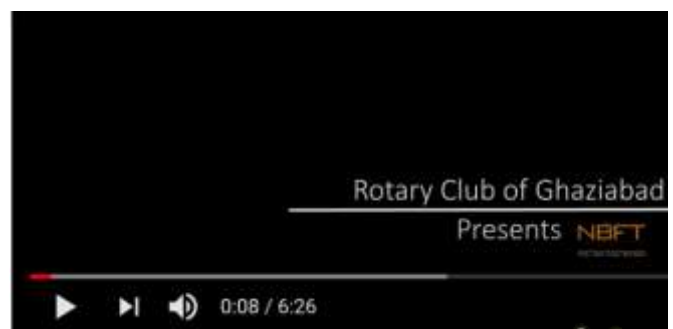
