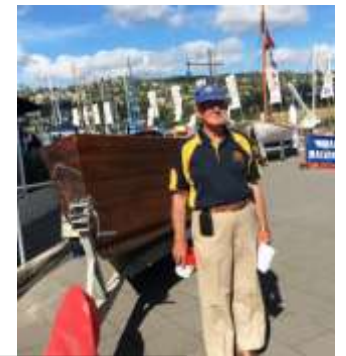
A huge thankyou to all the volunteers from the club, SES members and friends that made this event a success. The public at Festivale valued this service
