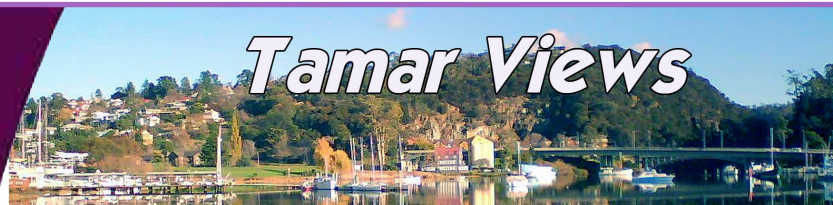

- March has been another busy month for ShelterBox. Our relief efforts in Gaza have been stepped up, with the commitment of thousands of tents for those left homeless by the continued conflict. In Malawi, a ShelterBox Response is investigating how we can respond the recent floods and, as you'll read below, our second project in Somalia is well underway.

April will see our Kokoda Trekkers head off for Papua New Guinea. The team has already raised over \$30,000 and hopes to reach their target of \$50,000 in the coming weeks. If you think you and your friends or work colleagues might be interested in a shorter, less arduous adventure, then check out the Three Peaks Challenge below or have a crack at the Sydney City 2 Surf and raise some much needed funds for disaster relief!
